#### XII. Junior Discussion – Izzy Israel

- a. Keeping momentum here in middle TN and spread it across the state
- b. Catering to all skill levels creating a safe environment
- c. Getting local shops more involved
  - i. Bike recycling programs?
  - ii. Race bike rentals?
- d. Consider staging process that addresses juniors with little to no skill set, to protect them and other riders
- e. Small fee for racing instead of free racing for juniors?
- f. Follow USAC age categories for state races

#### XIII. New Women's Masters Categories Proposal – Marsha Williams

- a. Propose to award TN State Championship jersey to Master Women 40+ at the state championship road race and criterium.
- b. Currently, a 35+ jersey is awarded at the state championship time trial, and this could be upped to 40+ to stay in synch with the proposed RR and Crit ages.
- c. Consider having the Masters Women race at a separate event in order not to dilute the Women 1/2/3 and Women 4 category based races.

#### XIV. Discussion of 2016 Road Masters Categories

- a. Discussed pros and cons of current Masters configuration with alternative configuration: 35+ (1-3), 45+ (1-4), and 55+ (1-5) with 45+ and 55+ normally being run in a single field.
- b. Current configuration tends to favor increased participation, while the alternative configuration tents to favor age based racing with minimal regard to category.
- c. Request an email from each club summarizing their feelings on the Masters categories

#### XV. Chip Timing Discussion – Izzy Israel

- a. Izzy has begun some research into chip timing for TN races, with the hope of demoing and further researching the technology at some of the Tuesday night Harpeth rides at the Nashville Fairgrounds.
- b. Izzy will also research and document a cost model for the technology
- c. Michael Edens notes that most neighboring LA's do implement some form of chip technology at either the LA level or 3<sup>rd</sup> party level.

#### XVI. Club of the Year Changes

- a. Suggested to change the current Club of the Year competition from being club based to being team based.
- b. Larger clubs with multiple teams have an advantage and going to a team structure will level the playing field for some of the smaller clubs and teams.
