2019 Rules - TBAR Point Series Changes

Article 1 - TBAR Points Series Competition

1. TBAR Categories

1.1 The TBAR Road Racing Series Competition is divided in the following categories:

Added Masters Women 40+ as a standard BAR category.

4. Awarding TBAR Points

4.1 TBAR points are awarded to the top riders in each race at TBRA events pursuant to the Point Series Scales document on the series rules page of the website.

Note that the purse level thresholds have changed for 2019:

Div I: \$6,000+

Div II: \$3,000 - \$5,999

Div III: <\$3,000

Also note that the Div II scale has been adjusted: 30 / 25 / 18 / 15 / 12 / 10 / 8 / 6 / 4 / 2 / 1

4.3 Overall TBAR Series positions shall be calculated based on the TBAR Point Scale to determine a racers "earned-point performances" (i.e., the number of points awarded under the scale in accord with finish position and the event's Division). TBAR positions for each racer shall be the sum of their highest earned-points performances from a maximum number of events in each road discipline, as follows:

Road Races Best five (5) earned-points performances
Time Trials Best five (5) earned-points performances
Criteriums Best seven (7) earned-points performances

Article III. TBRA Tennessee State Championships

1. TBRA State Championship Road Events

1.1 A Tennessee State Championship jersey will be awarded to the highest placing eligible rider (see rule 1.3 below) in each road event (road race, criterium, and time trial), for each category and age group competition

recognized by TBRA. Removed reference to Masters Women 40+ since this is now a standard BAR category and will be awarded jerseys by default.

- 1.2 USAC or TBRA State Championship medals will be awarded to the top three eligible finishers in each of the following categories:
 - Women, Masters TT: five year age groups beginning at age 40 (changed from 35 to 40 to coincide with the new Masters Women 40+ BAR category)
